## **CLASSES:**

Junior Puppy class	3–6 months
Youth class	6–9 months
Junior class	9–18 months
Intermediate class	15–24 months
Open class	15 months and older
Working class	from 15 months (attach a working certificate to the application)
Champion class	from 15 months (attach a championship certificate to the application)
Veteran class	from 8 years
Honorary class	no ranking or title

## **Titles and competitions:**

**CAJC** – the Slovak Junior Beauty Champion title may be awarded to a male and female dog graded Excellent 1 in the junior class.

**CAC** – the Slovak Beauty Champion title may be awarded to a male and female dog graded Excellent 1 in the intermediate, open, working, and champion classes.

**Res.CAC** – may be awarded to a male and female dog graded “Excellent 2” in the intermediate, open, working, and champion classes, provided that a CAC was awarded in that class.

**Best Puppy** – The title may be awarded to a male or female dog that wins first place in the puppy class with a “very promising” rating, following a prior victory in its class and gender against a male/female dog of a different color.

**Best Youth** – The title may be awarded to a male or female dog that wins first place in the youth class with a “very promising” rating, following a prior victory in its class and gender against a male/female dog of a different color.

**Best Black Male** – The title may be awarded to the best black male from among the “Excellent 1” competitors in the Intermediate, Open, Working, and Champion classes.

**Best Fawn Male** – The title may be awarded to the best fawn male from among the “Excellent 1” competitors in the Intermediate, Open, Working, and Champion classes.

**Best Black Female** – This title may be awarded to the best female of the breed from among the dogs rated Excellent 1 in the Intermediate, Open, Working, and Champion classes.

**Best Fawn Female** – This title may be awarded to the best female of the breed from among the dogs that received an “Excellent 1” rating in the Intermediate, Open, Working, or Champion classes.

**Junior Club Winner** – may be awarded to a male and female dog awarded the CAJC title.

**BOJ** – Best Junior of the Breed – the most beautiful male or female dog of the breed, selected from among the holders of the CAJC title.

**Club Winner** – may be awarded to a male and female dog awarded the CAC title in the intermediate, open, working, and champion classes.

**Veteran Club Winner** – the title may be awarded to a male and female dog in the veteran class with an Excellent 1 rating.

**BOV** – Best Veteran. A male or female dog from the group of winners in the veteran class – “Excellent 1” (No CAC is awarded in the veteran class).

**BOB** – Best of Breed – The male and female dogs that received the CAJC title, the best adult male and female (Club Winner male and female), and the male and female dogs that received an Excellent 1 in the veteran class will compete.

**BOS** - Best of Opposite Sex - the BOS title is awarded to an individual of the opposite sex from the BOB winner.

### **Competitions:**

**Best Couple** – A male and female dog that were judged at the show and are owned by the same owner. The owner must be listed on the pedigree.

**Best Breeder’s Group** - A breeder may enter a minimum of three and a maximum of five dogs from their own breeding program into the competition, provided they are from different matings (at least from two different sires or dams) and have been judged at the show. The dogs do not have to be owned by the breeder.

**It will also be possible to register for competitions on the day of the exhibition.**

**Veterinary Requirements:**

Each dog must have a veterinary certificate with valid vaccinations against rabies, distemper, parvovirus, and hepatitis administered at least 1 month and no more than 1 year prior to the show, or as indicated by the vaccine's expiration date. Foreign exhibitors must have valid vaccinations confirmed in their Pet Passport.

**General Provisions:**

The show is organized in accordance with the FCI and SKJ show regulations. Only dogs registered in FCI-recognized studbooks may participate in the show. Acceptance of the entry will be confirmed in writing 10 days prior to the show. Imported dogs must be registered in SKJ stud books. The exhibitor agrees to pay the show fees even if they do not participate in the show for any reason. If the show is canceled for reasons beyond the organizer's control, the entry fees will be used to cover incurred expenses. The organizer reserves the right to refuse a dog's entry into the show without providing a reason. The organizer is not liable for any damage caused by or to a dog.
